<b>Basic Admissions Requirements</b>	Five academic courses, overall average of 70% English 12 min 65%, four additional academic courses minimum of 60%
<b>Minimum Admissions Average</b>	70%
<b>IB Information</b>	Our IB policies are similar to everyone else. Minimum certificate score of 24 is required for full program. Individual scores of 5,6,7 will receive transfer credit in the first year. We will award up to the full first year in credit. <a href="#">IB Information</a>

<b>Timing of offers/grades used</b>	Our application opens on October 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2021 and students will typically receive their admission decision 1-3 weeks after submitting all necessary documents. We will evaluate grade 11, grade 12 or a combination of both at that time for a conditional acceptance.  We do not have any limited undergrad programs at this time but students are encouraged to submit their application before our scholarship deadline of March 1 <sup>st</sup> .

<b>Guaranteed Scholarship Program</b>	We guarantee scholarships with an 80% average or higher. All awards are renewable. Will use in progress marks if available.
