INSTITUTION INFORMATION

Program Highlights:	At McGill University, students receive a world-class educational experience. Our 22 faculties and schools offer over 300 academic programs to choose from, including Astrophysics, Bioengineering, Classical Music, Environmental Sciences, International Business, and World Religions. The Macdonald campus is home to programs in Environmental and Agricultural Sciences, Bioresource Engineering, as well as Food and Nutritional Sciences. Students have the opportunity to obtain an interdisciplinary degree and take courses in a variety of faculties and schools. With the highest entering averages of any Canadian university, the quality of the student population is exceptional. It is an English language university surrounded by French culture and history. Studying in Montreal offers English-speaking students a wonderful opportunity to learn French, and courses in French as a Second Language are open to students in any program.
Student Population:	There are over 40 000 students, with 27 000 studying at the undergraduate level. Students represent approximately 150 countries around the world (2000 students are based at Macdonald Campus, of which 1400 are undergraduate students). Our student body is the most internationally diverse of any research-intensive university in the country.

Minimum Alberta Admissions Requirements:	Admission is based on McGill's calculation of each student's "Top 5" academic Grade 12 level courses, including any program pre-requisites. <i>Notes: Math 30-2 can be counted in the "Top 5" average, but it is not accepted as a math prerequisite for Faculties in which math is required. Marks for failed or repeated courses will be taken into consideration and may be used in the 'Top 5' calculation, as required.</i>

Scholarship Application Deadline:	One-year entrance scholarships are automatically granted following review of the admission application (no separate application required, deadline is February 1 st). Major entrance scholarships applications and documents are due on February 7 th .																				
Decision Criteria:	In general, applicants are expected to have a minimum 97% on all academic grade 12 and 11 courses and/or rank in the top 1% of class.

Treatment of Diploma Marks	If a course has been completed, we consider the provincial result, even if it is a blended grade.																				
Transcript Requirements	Applicants must self-report all Grade 11 and Grade 12 level courses, regardless of the year in which they were taken, on the Minerva online portal. McGill will select the courses to be included in the "Top 5" calculation. Self-reported grades will be verified against official grades by the admission officer when proof of graduation and final transcripts are submitted. COUNSELLORS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO SUBMIT TRANSCRIPTS DURING THE REVIEW PERIOD.
