MCGILL'S COMPETITIVE ADMISSION PROCESS

- Admission is competitive and subject to availability of space; presentation of the minimum requirements does not guarantee acceptance.
- If admitted, you are expected to maintain your level of academic performance through to the completion of your pre-McGill studies

CANADIAN HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA (OTHER THAN ONTARIO AND QUEBEC)

- Applicants must have obtained, prior to the start of classes, a high school diploma that gives them access to university education in their home province or territory.
- Admission is based on McGill's calculation of your 'Top 5' academic Grade 12 courses, including the prerequisites for the program to which you applied. To see the list of accepted academic courses, go to mcgill.ca/undergraduate-admissions/apply/requirements/canadian
- In the case of repeated courses the best result will be used in the 'Top 5' calculation, as required.
- Grade 12 English or French will be included in the 'Top 5' calculation, depending on the language of instruction at your school.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE

- Applicants completing the IB Diploma at a school in Canada will normally be considered for admission based on their 'Top 5' average and will be required to self-report marks in percentage format. Predicted IB results may be required for some programs.
- Students may subsequently be granted advanced standing credits based on their final IB results and their entering program. Consult mcgill.ca/transferecredit/prospective for more details.

PROOF OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Applicants who have lived and attended high school and/or university, for at least four years, in a country where English is the acknowledged primary language, are not required to provide further proof of English proficiency.

DOCUMENTATION

- You will receive an email acknowledgment within 48 hours after submitting the application for admission. The login information provided in the email will allow you to access your Minerva account to view your application status. **It is your responsibility to verify your status and ensure the completion of your application.**
- You are required to **self-report your grades**, after January 5, using the designated web form accessible through Minerva (Music and Religious Studies applicants are excluded and will upload a copy of their unofficial transcript). Information on when and how to self-report grades can be found at mcgill.ca/undergraduate-admissions/apply/self-reporting-canada
- You will be considered for admission in two rounds. If you do not receive a decision in the first 'round' you must update your grades and re-submit the self-reported grades form.
- Additional supporting documents (such as recommendation letters and personal statements) are not used for admission consideration and should only be submitted if required by one of the following:
