JOINT DEGREES options to pursue joint degrees of bachelor of commerce and bachelor of music or bachelor of commerce (co-operative) and bachelor of arts

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (INTERMEDIATE/SECONDARY)

offered as a second degree; available with conjoint diploma in technology education

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (POST-SECONDARY) available as a first or second degree

BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (PRIMARY/ELEMENTARY) available as a first or second degree. A French immersion option available as a second degree
